**Deadlines:** Tournament entry forms and fees must be received no later than September 19, 2011. Please email Matt (ship@wisc.edu) once you have placed your form/fee in the mail. The tournament field will be set by September 21, 2011; teams will be notified via email regarding their team's status that evening. Start times will be emailed out to the primary contact for each time no later than Monday October 24, 2011. When making travel arrangements, all teams must be prepared for an 8am start time on Friday October 28, 2011. Teams will obtain a copy of the tournament draw/schedule upon checking in for their first match.

**Tournament Format:** All matches will follow the World Team Tennis Format. There will be 8 pools of 4 teams. Round robin pool play will take place all day on Friday October 28<sup>th</sup>. Based on pool play results, all four teams will then be placed into corresponding brackets (Platinum, Gold, Silver, Bronze). In the event of a 2-way tie within a pool, whichever team won the direct match will move on to the higher pool. In the event of a 3-way tie, the tiebreaker will be highest percentage of overall games won. Bracket play will take place on Saturday October 29<sup>th</sup>. All teams in the platinum bracket will place 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, whereas the Gold/Silver/Bronze brackets will only place the 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> teams. All teams are guaranteed at least 4 matches.

**Rosters:** The World Team Tennis Format requires at least 2 men and 2 women per roster. Teams are allowed a maximum of 10 players per roster. Rosters must

be submitted to Matthew Ship via email (ship@wisc.edu) by 12:00pm CST, Wednesday October 26, 2011. No players will be permitted to play if their name does not appear on the submitted roster.

**Tournament Selection Process:** In the event of an excess of 32 teams submitting entry forms/fees, we will conduct a tournament selection process. The tournament field will be chosen based on a variety of factors, including but not limited to: competitiveness, team's history with the Badger Classic, size of program to ensure growth within Tennis on Campus, etc. Teams will be notified of their tournament entry status no later than September 21<sup>st</sup>. Teams not chosen to participate will have their entry fee checks voided (and returned, if requested). In the event that we do not have at least 32 teams enter the tournament, we will begin allowing "B" teams into the tournament. "B" Teams will be required to pay a full entry fee as well.

**Tournament Hotels:** We have worked with several local hotels to reserve blocks of rooms at discounted rates. Once selected into the tournament field, captains/presidents will receive an additional email with travel information (including airports, rental cars, hotels, etc).
